## **2020 \$50 10 oz. 99.99% PURE SILVER COIN – MAGNIFICENT MAPLE LEAVES**

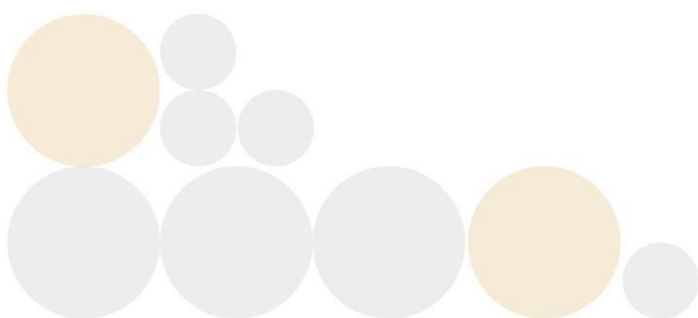

The reverse image by Canadian artist Celia Godkin features two sugar maple leaves. Pointing upward, the overlapping leaves are attached by their stems to a single twig at the bottom of the image. The leaves are engraved with careful precision using a variety of textures to lend depth to the image.
